

ORDINANCE No. 474

Establishing the grade on part of Water & Ellsworth Streets

An Ordinance changing and establishing the grade of all that portion of Water Street in the City of Albany, Oregon between the East line of Broadline Street and the West line of Lyon Street, and all that portion of the grade on Ellsworth Street in said City, between the North line of First Street, and the center line of Water Street, so as to conform to the survey of the grade of said portion of said Water Street and Ellsworth Street as made by, and shown by the survey and plat thereof, made by J. A. Warner, City Engineer, in the year 1906, and filed in the Office of the Recorder of said City, on the 11th day of Sept 1906, and to repeal all ordinances, or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows in Section 1. That the grade of all that portion of Water Street, between the East line of Broadline Street, and the West line of Lyon Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, and all that portion of the grade on Ellsworth Street, in said City, between the North line of First Street, and the Center line of Water Street, be, and the same is hereby changed and established, so as to conform to the survey of the grade of said portion of said Water Street, and Ellsworth Street, as made by, and shown by the survey and plat thereof, of City Engineer, J. A. Warner, made in the year 1906, and filed in the Office of the Recorder of said City on the 11th day of Sept 1906.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in Conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after thirty days from its approval by the Mayor.
