

## ORDINANCE NO. 481.

Declaring probable cost of assessment for paving  
Terry Street.

An ordinance to ascertain, determine & declare the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by resolution No. 8 adopted by said Council, on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1909 to pave Terry street in said City from the North Court line of Third street to the South line of Second street; to ascertain, assess, & determine & declare the proportionate share of such ~~for~~<sup>the</sup> cost of such improvements of said Terry street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Terry street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens, as provided by the Charter of said City; to declare an emergency.

Whereas, on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1909 the Council of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineers of said City to make Plans & Specifications for the improvement of Terry street from the North Court<sup>line</sup> of Third street, to the South line of Second street in said City with hard surface pavement, & for the installing of a proper drainage system; as for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Terry street, the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such Plans & specifications, estimates of probable cost be filed in the City Recorder's office of said City, on or before the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1909, said resolution being Endorsed Resolution No. 3 and adopted the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1909; and

Whereas, the City Engineers of said City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution No. 3 made Plans & specifications, & estimates as directed by said resolution for said improvement of said Terry street on the manner specified in said resolution No. 3 & filed said Plans & specifications & estimates in the Recorder's Office of the said City of Albany, on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1909, endorsed

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"City Engineer is shown <sup>in</sup> specifications for the improvement of the following named streets, to wit: Second street from the East Curb line of Washington street to the West Curb line of Lynn street, Terry street from the North Curb line of Third street to the South line of Second street; Broadalbin Street from the North Curb line of Third street to the South line of Second street; Cleveland street from the North Curb line of Third street to the South line of Second street; <sup>in</sup> the estimated of the work to be done on each of said streets separately, and the probable cost thereof to each of said streets separately."

Whereas, the said City Council, on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1909 by Resolution No. 8, duly adopted by said Council, determined that it was expedient that said Council propose to improve Terry street, from the North Curb line of Third street to the South line of Second street in the manner provided in the said resolution No. 8,

Whereas, in this by said Resolution No. 8 adopted as aforesaid by said Council, the City Recorder of said City who duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of the said proposed improvement of said Terry street, from the North Curb line of Third street to the South line of Second street as provided by the Charter of said City;

Whereas, said City Recorder in pursuance of said order, in direction of said City Council of said City of Albany, did duly give notice of the said proposed improvement of said Terry street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City;

Whereas, said Council, in this by said Resolution No. 8 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Terry street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Terry street to be improved as mentioned in said Resolution No. 8 to be the sum of \$ 2770.21 and the total probable cost of making said improvement.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the probable cost of making  
said improvement of said Ferry street in the  
City of Albany, Oregon, from the North Curb line  
of Third street to the South line of Second street  
in the manner heretofore determined by the  
Council of said City of Albany in and by said  
Resolution No 8 is hereby declared to be the  
sum of \$ 2930.51.

Section 2. That the proportionate share  
of the said probable costs of said improvement  
of said Ferry street assessed upon each lot  
or part thereof adjacent to and part of  
said Ferry street to be improved as aforesaid  
as determined by said Council in  
and by said Resolution No 8 is hereby ascertained  
and declared to be the sum set forth immediately  
after the separate description of each of such  
lot or part thereof, as follows:

of City liens of the said City of Albany, as  
provided in the Charter of said City.

Section 4. In as much as there is  
necessity for, and the general welfare of  
said City demands that the said impro-  
vement of said Terry Street be commenced  
immediately in order that said impro-  
vement of said street may be completed  
before the rainy season sets in, an  
emergency is hereby declared to exist,  
and this ordinance shall be in full force  
and effect from and after its approval by  
the Mayor of said City of Albany.
