

Declaring Probable cost & Assessment for Paving  
Ellsworth Street.

Ord 483 The ordinance to ascertain, determine and declare the  
Declaring Probable cost of certain improvements which  
probable the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined  
cost + assessment by resolution No. 110 adopted by said Council, on  
for Paving the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1909 to make on Ellsworth  
-Ellsworth street in said City from the North Curbing line of  
St. Third street to the South line of Second street;  
to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the  
Proportional share of such Probable cost of  
such improvements of said Ellsworth street  
that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof  
adjacent to said part of said Ellsworth street  
to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of  
said City to enter a statement of such assess-  
ment in the Docket of City Liens, as provided  
by the Charter of said City; and to declare an emer-  
gency.

Whereas, on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1909 the Council  
of the City of Albany, Clatsop County, Oregon, duly  
adopted a resolution requiring the City Engi-  
neer of said City to make plans and specifica-  
tions for the improvement of Ellsworth  
street from the North Curbing line of Third  
street to the South line of Second street in  
said City, with hard surface pavement,  
and for the installing of a proper drainage  
system, and for the estimates of the work to be done  
by said portion of said Ellsworth street, and the  
Probable cost thereof, and requiring that such  
plans, specifications, estimates and Probable  
cost be filed in the City Recorder's office of  
said City, on or before the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of March  
1909, said resolution being endorsed, Resolution  
No. 5 and adopted, the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March, 1909; and

Whereas, the City Engineer of said City of Albany,  
pursuant to said resolution No. 5 made plans,  
specifications, and estimates as directed by said  
resolution, for said improvement of said  
Ellsworth street in the manner specified in  
said resolution No. 5 and filed plans, specifications  
and estimates in the Recorder's office of the said  
City of Albany, on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1909.



Declaring probable cost and assessment for paving  
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endorsed, "City Engineer's Plans and Specifications for the improvement of the following named streets, to-wit: -

Second Street from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the West Curb line of Lyon Street; Ferry Street from the North Curb line of Third Street to the South line of Second Street; Broad Albion Street from the North Curb line of Third Street to the South line of Second Street; Ellsworth Street from the North Curb line of Third Street to the South line of Second Street; and the estimates of the work to be done on each of said streets separately, and the probable cost thereof on each of said streets separately."

Whereas, the said City Council, on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1909 by Resolution No. 10 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient that said Council propose to improve Ellsworth Street from the North Curb line of Third Street to the South line of Second Street in the manner provided in the said resolution No. 10;

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 10 adopted as aforesaid by said Council, the City Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of the said proposed improvement of said Ellsworth Street from the North Curb line of Third Street to the South line of Second Street as provided by the Charter of the said City of Albany;

Whereas, said City Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of said City Council of said City of Albany, did duly give notice of the said proposed improvement of said Ellsworth Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City;

Whereas, said Council in and by said Resolution No. 10 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Ellsworth Street to be paid by the

owners of the real property adjacent to a  
 section of said Ellsworth Street to be  
 provided as mentioned in said Resolution  
 No. 10 to be the sum of \$2726.80 and the  
 total probable cost of making said improve-  
 ment of said Ellsworth Street to be the sum of  
 \$2897.10 therefore:

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:  
 Section 1. That the probable cost of making  
 said improvement of said Ellsworth Street  
 in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West  
 curb line of Third Street to the South line of Second  
 Street in the manner heretofore determined by  
 the Council of said City of Albany, in and by said  
 Resolution No. 10 is hereby declared to be the  
 sum of \$2897.10.

Section 2. That the proportionate share of  
 the said probable cost of said improvement  
 of said Ellsworth Street assessed upon each  
 lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of  
 said Ellsworth Street to be improved as given  
 said lot as determined by said Council in and  
 by said Resolution No. 10 is hereby ascertain-  
 ed and declared to be the sum set out and placed  
 immediately after the separate description  
 of each of such lot or part thereof, as follows:  
 Description of each lot or part thereof  
 adjacent to said improvement of said Ellsworth  
 Street:

West Side, Between Second & Third Streets,  
 Block 17.

Julia Shea -

Lot 5, in Block 17, in the City of Albany,  
 Lane County, Oregon. 103 feet on Ellsworth St.  
 Assessed at \$609.<sup>62</sup>

Mary Wood -

2 1/2 feet off of east side of lot 4 in Block  
 17 in the City of Albany, Lane County, Oregon,  
 103 feet on Ellsworth Street. Assessed at \$609.<sup>63</sup>

Declaring probable cost of assessment for paving  
 Ellsworth Street.

Also proportionate share of cost of pavement  
 abutting the alley on East side of Ellsworth  
 Street, Block 18. (Assessed at. \$73.17)

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of  
 Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and  
 directed to immediately enter a statement  
 of the assessment made and declared by  
 this ordinance, together with the names of  
 the respective owners of such lots or part  
 thereof herein above described in the  
 docket of City liens of the said City of Albany,  
 as provided in the Charter of said City.

Section 4. In as much as there is  
 necessity for and the general welfare  
 of the said City demands that the said  
 improvement of said Ellsworth street be  
 commenced immediately in order that  
 said improvement of said street may be  
 completed before the rainy season sets  
 in, an emergency is hereby declared  
 to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force  
 and effect from and after its approval by the  
 Mayor of said City of Albany.
