An ordinance declaring a surplus on ac-  
count of street paving by the Warren Con-  
struction Company on their second con-  
tract on the following named streets, to-wit:  
Second Street from the East Curb line of  
Washington Street to the West Curb line of  
Lyon Street, on Ferry, Broadalbin and  
Hilwood Streets from the South line of  
Second Street to the North Curb line of  
Third Street, and directing that a warrant  
issue to the person or persons who paid  
such surplus in the payment of their assess-  
ments as owners of the real estate abutting  
upon said streets so improved for the propor-  
tionate share of such surplus, and to de-  
clare an emergency.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of five and one half  
per cent is hereby ascertained and declared  
to exist upon the completion of the second four  
contracts entered into by the City of Albany  
with the Warren Construction Company for  
the improvement of Second Street from the  
East Curb line of Washington Street to the  
West Curb line of Lyon Street, and on Ferry,  
Broadalbin and Hilwood Streets from the  
South line of Second Street to the North Curb  
line of Third Street of the sum assessed  
for the making of said improvement of  
each parcel of property included in said  
contracts and in favor of each of the several  
owners of the various parcels of real estate  
abutting upon the heretofore assessed for  
making such improvement and entered  
upon the Docket of Liens of the City of  
Albany. Enorm.

Section 2. The Recorder of said City is  
hereby directed to draw warrants on the  
City Treasurer of said City in favor of  
the following named persons, owners of  
such various parcels of real estate
