An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 457  
entitled "An Ordinance granting the Chas H  
Spaulding Logging Company permission to erect  
a lumber yard structure on lots three and four  
in Block Three, in the City of Albany, and to  
remove a barn on said lots."

Passed the Council August 25<sup>th</sup> 1908, and  
Approved August 26<sup>th</sup> 1908.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

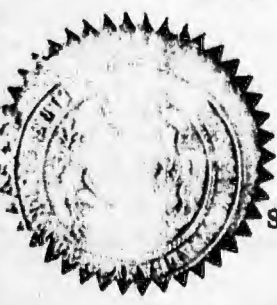
Section 1. That all of Ordinance number 457, entitled  
"An Ordinance granting the Chas. H. Spaulding Logging  
Company permission to erect a lumber yard  
structure on lots three and four in block three in the  
City of Albany, and to remove a barn on said lots"  
passed the Council August 25<sup>th</sup> 1908, and approved August  
26<sup>th</sup> 1908, be and the same is hereby repealed except  
that the Shed and Office now constructed on said lot  
four be allowed to remain, but not to be rebuilt.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full  
force and effect from and after thirty days after  
its approval by the Mayor.
