Ordinance directing and authorizing the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with the Northwestern Corporation for the installation, establishment and maintenance of three electric lights upon the Wagon bridge crossing the Willamette River at Albany, Oregon, providing the terms of said contract, prescribing the manner of its execution and declaring an emergency.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into a contract in the name, behalf, and for the benefit of the City of Albany, with the Northwestern Corporation, which contract shall provide for the establishment and installation of three incandescent electric lights of not less than sixteen candle power each, upon the Wagon bridge across the Willamette River at Albany, Oregon, at such places thereon as may be agreed upon, and shall also provide for the maintenance and continuance of said three lights thereon, and that the same shall be kept burning by said Northwestern Corporation continuously during the entire night time, that is from the time darkness begins in the evening until daylight in the following morning, of each and every night for a term of ten years, beginning on the 11th day of April 1910, and ending on the 1st day of April 1920, at and for a sum not greater than one dollar per month for said three lights, and that the City shall replace such lamps as may be wrongfully or maliciously broken by anyone not an officer, agent or employe of said party of the second part.

Section 2. That said contract shall be signed for and on behalf of the City of Albany by the Mayor of said City, and attested by the Recorder under the municipal seal of said City.

Section 3. Inasmuch as there is no light upon said bridge now, and by reason thereof the traveling public is in constant danger of accident, and full and free use of said highway is thereby impeded, an

Emergency is hereby declared to exist and the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same is hereby exempted from the referendum.
