

## ORDINANCE No. 508.

Declaring probable cost and assessment for paving part of First Street from Washington to Calapooia Sts.

Ord. No. 508. Declaring probable cost and assessment for paving part of First Street from Washington to Calapooia Sts.

The Ordinance to ascertain, determine and declare the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by resolution No. 6 adopted by said Council, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1910 to make on First Street in said City from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the East Curb line of Calapooia Street, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvements of said First Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said First Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment of in the pocket of City Liens, as provided by the Charter of said City; and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 1909 the Council of the City of Albany, Lane County, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of First Street from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the East Curb line of Calapooia Street in said City, with Bitumathic pavement, and for the installing of a proper drainage system and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said First Street, and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the City Recorder's office of said City, on or before the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1909, said resolution being embodied in Resolution No. 14 and adopted the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 1909, and

Whereas, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution No. 14 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for said improvement of said First Street in the manner specified in said resolution No. 14, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of the said

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City of Albany on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1910, endorsed, City Engineers Plans and Specifications for the improvement of the following named streets, to-wit: -  
First Street from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the East Curb line of Calapooia Street; and the estimates of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof on said street.

Whereas, the said City Council, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, 1910 by Resolution No. 6 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient that said Council proposed to improve First Street, from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the East Curb line of Calapooia Street in the manner provided in the said resolution No. 6, and

Whereas, and by said Resolution No. 6 adopted as aforesaid by said Council, the City Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of the said proposed improvement of said First Street from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the East Curb line of Calapooia Street as provided by the Charter of the said City of Albany; and

Whereas, said City Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of said City Council of said City of Albany, did duly give notice of the said proposed improvement of said portion of First Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

Whereas, said Council, in and by said Resolution No. 6 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said First Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said First Street to be improved as mentioned in

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said Resolution No. 6 to be the sum of \$ 3,069.38 and the total probable cost of making said improvement of said portion of First Street to be the sum of \$ 4106.61 hereafter.

That the People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That First Street from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the East Curb line of Calapasia Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be improved as follows; to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.

Second: By paving the roadway of said street, full width, with full intersections, with Bitulithic Pavement.

Third: By laying and constructing Bitulithic Headers.

Fourth: By constructing Inlets.

Fifth: By constructing Catch Basins.

Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 6 and the Plans and Specifications of said proposed improvement, filed in the Office of the City Recorder by the City Engineer of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1910.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said First Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the East Curb line of Washington Street to the East Curb line of Calapasia Street in the manner hereafter determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 6 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$ 4106.61.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of the said probable cost of said improvement of said portion of First Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said First Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 6 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the

Section 4. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessment made and declared by this Ordinance together with the names of the respective owners of such lot or part thereof herein above described in the docket of City liens of the said City of Albany, as provided in the Charter of said City.

Section 5. Inasmuch as there is necessity for and the general welfare of said City demands that the said improvement of said part of First Street be commenced immediately in order that said improvement of said street may be completed before the rainy season sets in, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor of said City of Albany.
