Establish grade on 4th Street betw. Montgomery & Jackson.

Ord No 521 An Ordinance to establish a grade on Fourth Street between Establishing Montgomery & Jackson Streets in the City of Albany, Linn County, grade on Oregon, and to repeal all ordinances or parts of Ordinances 4th from in Conflict herewith.

Montgomery & Jackson The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:

Section One.

The established grade of Fourth street between Montgomery and Jackson Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be in conformity with the survey and plan thereof made by J. A. Warner, Assistant City Engineer, and filed in the Office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, on the 27th day of July, A.D. 1910.


Section Two.
