

ORDINANCE NO. 384

Ord 584

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Fifth Street from the east curb line of Elm Street to the west curb line of Main Street, providing now the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damages to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and bonds for the giving by the Recorder of said City of previous notice for bids on the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Fifth Street from the east curb line of Elm Street to the west curb line of Main Street, except the intersection with Washington, Franklin, Broadway and Lyon Streets, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.

Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with gravel bitulithic pavement.

Third: By laying and constructing gravel bitulithic

headstones.

Fourth: By constructing catch basins.

Fifth: By constructing inlets.

Sixth: By laying a vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, the implementation of said plans, etc., filed in the office of the City Recorder of said City of Albany on the 18th day of April, 1912, in book "City Engineer's Plan and Estimates of the improvement of Fifth Street, from the east curb line of Elm Street to the west curb line of Main Street, and the estimated cost to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement, and portion of said improvement at the crossings of intersecting streets to be determined by the City Engineer of said City; the amount remaining to the City of Albany for said improvement to said street to be paid out of the funds of the City and arising therefrom and net of all expenses and losses to be ascertained and declared by the same to the City Council of said City of Albany on the 26th day of April, 1912, and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 6th day of May, 1912, no the last and full of this ordinance to said portion of said street.

The improvement to said Fifth Street will be completed

on the 1st day of October, 1912.

Section 1. - a. Bid on the making of said improvement of said

street to be made on the 1st day of October, 1912, noon,

unrestricted.

b. Any firm, corporation or person with whom or with whom

any contract may be made, shall be liable for the making of

said improvement, and no person in said improvement,

and at the time of making said contract, same, execute and

deliver to said City of Albany and sufficient bond, with good and

sufficient security in the sum of \$5,000.00 for the faithful per-

formance of said contract.

Section 2. - a. The firm, corporation or person enter-
ing into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said
improvement of said Fifth Street has 60 days to complete the same
certain the time mentioned and specified in such contract,
said time can be deemed to cover damages on account thereof
to the amount of \$10.00 per day, for each calendar day the comple-
tion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such con-
tract, such amount being paid to such contractor doing the
work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion
and payment is extended by the Board.

b. The payment of all money in day and nightable
weather and otherwise.

Section 3. - The Recorder of said City
hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice
of the making of said improvement of said portion of said
Fifth Street, by giving such notice to the people in the Albany
District as they may be published in the said City of Albany,
fully describing it and notice the time and manner of its making
and the cost of the improvement, until eight o'clock.
