

ORDINANCE NO. 586.

Ord 586

An Ordinance Authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, N. Y., to Enter into a Contract with the Warren Construction Company for the Improvement of Fifth Street, From the East Curb Line to Elm Street to the West Curb Line of Main Street.

The Purpose of the City is to lay out the line as follows:

Whereas, By Ordinance No. 387 of the City of Albany, it was ordered that the "new street line" City of Albany, from the east curb line of Fifth Street, across the West Curb line, to Elm Street, to the west curb line of Main Street, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade, becoming the roadway of said street, and width without intersections with grade little less than four feet.

Second: By constructing a curb stone.

Third: By constructing catch basins.

Fifth: By constructing manholes.

Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Such improvements to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, the governmental plans and specifications contained in the Civil Engineer's Office on file with the City Recorder of said City of Albany; and,

Whereas, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of said City give notice or bids in the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and,

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given to the City Recorder of said City, according to law and by ordinance of Council, to-wit: on the 4th day of August, 1881, the Warren Construction Company, a corporation of Portland, Oregon, presented its Ordinance of said City, to bid for such work improvement, which bid was made to the City, and the conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, to which a said bid and Warren Construction Company proposed to furnish all material and labor required, and to make all labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named lines:

Excavation per cubic yard, \$0.75

Fill, per cubic yard, \$0.20

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Gravel Bituminous Pavement, per square yard,	\$1.55
Gravel Bituminous Pavement, per linear foot,	\$ 0.87
Inlets Each Style 6 each,	\$ 15.00
Inlets, each, like B	\$ 8.20
Buried vitrified sewer pipe, per lineal foot,	\$ 0.55

And Whereas, said Warren Construction Company was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best transcript.

Ordered, That the said bid of the Warren Construction Company for said improvement of said described street, to and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into an contract in writing, with the said Warren Construction Company, for the making of said improvement as aforesaid, on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the agreements relative mentioned.

And Ordered to provide further, that the work of said improvement shall commence within thirty days after the signing of said contract, and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work agreed in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of October, 1902, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$25.00 per day on each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time; and that the Warren Construction Company furnish a bond in the sum of \$5,000.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as sureties one Surety Company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract, by the part of the Warren Construction Company, and further enjoining the City of Albany against associations or alliances to any other contractor or contractors, or persons arising out of said contract.
