

ORDINANCE NO. 600.

Ord 600

An ordinance authorizing and directing the City Treasurer of the City of Albany to invest the bond redemption fund. Whereas there has been collected and not issued in hands of the City Treasurer \$4,382.87 tax & civil administration fund and there will be collected approximately \$1,000 in the first calendar in October, Nov. 2, and

Upon which funds for which said tax was collected to be used until the anticipated money will produce no revenue, and Whereas the warrants of the City of Albany are demand by the Council to be paid in payment of said funds.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Action 1. The City Treasurer of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to invest the bond redemption fund now in hand and such sums as shall accrue in City warrants of the City of Albany at a sum not to exceed face and accrued interest and to reinvest said fund, if necessary, to the end that said bond redemption fund shall produce as much revenue as possible to said fund, and when said warrants are collected the interest paid upon such warrants shall be added to and become a part of said bond redemption fund.

Action 2. Whereas existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
