

## ORDINANCE NO. 618.

Saville, Attorney, Albany, Oregon

Ordinance

No. 608

Cap 711

On ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined in resolution No. 24 adopted by said council on the 26th day of June, 1912, to make up Pine Street from the South line of Front Street to the 40th curb line of Salem Road; to ascertain also, determine and decide the proportionate share of such probable costs, when in progress of said Pine Street that is assessed upon a lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Pine Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said city to enter a statement of such assessment in the books of City Liens as provided by the charter of said city.

Whereas, on the 8th day of May 1912, the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, in resolution ordered the City Engineers to said city to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Pine Street, from the South line of Front Street to the 40th curb line of Salem Road in said city by grading said street to the required cut grade and paving same, and for the estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Pine Street and the probable cost thereof; and

Whereas, the City Engineers of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Order, made said plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Order for the improvement of said Pine Street in the manner specified in said Order and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said city on the 12th day of June, 1912; and

Whereas, the said City Council on the 26th day of June, 1912 by resolution No. 24 in a like manner directed by said council determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council be enabled to improve Pine Street from the South line of Front Street to the 40th curb line of Salem Road in the manner provided in said resolution No. 24; and

Whereas, in and by said resolution No. 24 adopted as aforesaid by the council, the City Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Pine Street from the South line of Front Street to the 40th curb line of Salem Road, as, provided by the charter of said City of Albany; and

Whereas, the City Recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of Pine Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and

Whereas, the said council in and by said resolution No. 24 aforesaid had determined the total probable cost of

said improvement of said Pine Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Pine Street to be imposed as mentioned in said resolution No. 24 to be the sum of \$31.31 and the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Pine Street to be the sum of \$559.01.

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Pine Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the intersection of Front Street to the North curb line of Tolman Road shall be improved as follows:

First. By grading said street to the required sub-grade.

Second. Resurfacing said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, twelve feet wide.

All in accordance with the said resolution No. 24 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the City Recorder of the said City of Albany on the 12th day

of June, 1912.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Pine Street in the City of Albany, Oregon from the South line of Front Street to the North curb line of Tolman Road in the manner herebefore determined by the council of the said City of Albany in and by said resolution No. 24 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$559.01.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Pine Street, assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Pine Street to be imposed as a tax and its determined by said council in and by said resolution No. 24, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the amount and placed immediately after the separate description of each lot or part of a lot or lots adjacent thereto.

Description of Backlot on east side of land adjacent to said improvement of said Pine Street.
