

Ordinance No. 610  
An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with John Baugh for the improvement of the L Street, from the west curb line of Baker Street to the west curb line of Union Street.

Whereas, By ordinance No. 592 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the council on the 5th day of July, 1912, it was ordered that the L Street in the City of Albany, to-wit, this street from the west curb line of Baker Street to the east curb line of Railroad Street be improved in the following manner, to-wit,

First. By grading said street to the proper curb grades.

Second. By paving the roadway of said street, full width, with full intersection, in concrete pavements.

Third. By laying and constructing concrete leaders.

Fourth. By constructing insets.

Fifth. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

That improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans and specifications and estimate of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, and,

Whereas, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvements in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and,

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made, and given in the City Recorder of said City, according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: On the 11th day of August, 1912, the bid presented to the recorder of said city was bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the attorney, by which said bid was made, for the purpose of furnishing all materials and implements and labor in the latter necessary to make the above described improvement in the following manner:

at \$30 excavation, per cubic yard	\$ 504	\$ 231.57
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23 ft. Concrete one square yard	\$ 1.24	\$ 280.172
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21 ft. Con. leaders, per linear foot	32¢	68.00
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of 3 mats, each	\$ 15.00	60.00
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200 ft. inch vitrified sewer pipe per linear foot	\$ 1.50	\$ 300.00
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Total	\$ 4760.62
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And, Whereas, said A. H. Baugh was the low bidder and was awarded the contract and will be the contractor.

ORDINANCE NO. 10

Rewritten, Albany, Oregon

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the said bid of the said C. L. Pugh for the improvement of said Street next to and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of the City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said C. L. Pugh for the making of said improvement as aforesaid or behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms and conditions in said bid and the agreement hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that work of said improvement shall commence within Thirty days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted until completed, that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed not before the first day of October, 1912, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the sum of \$25.00 per day for each and everyday the work is delayed beyond said specified time and that said C. L. Pugh furnish material in the amount of two thousand dollars to be afforded by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditional for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said C. L. Pugh and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claims or losses for labor, work or materials on the part of any person arising out of such contract.
