

Ordinance  
 An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with John Pugh for the improvement, to-wit, this street from the west curb line of Baker Street to the west curb line of Union Street.

Whereas, By ordinance, No. 597 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the council on the 5th day of July, 1912, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, to-wit, this street from the west curb line of Baker Street to the west curb line of Union Street be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street, full width, with full intersection, in concrete pavement.
- Third: By raising and constructing concrete curbs.
- Fourth: By constructing inlets.
- Fifth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans and specifications and estimate of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany, and,

Whereas, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made, and given by the City Recorder of said City, according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: On the 14th day of August, 1912, John Pugh presented to the council of said city his bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the council, by which said bid said John Pugh proposed to furnish all material and implement and labor in the labor necessary to make the above described improvement at the following named prices:

And Whereas, said John Pugh was the lowest bidder on said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best therefore

Newberg, Albany, Oregon

The People of the City of Albany Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the said bid of the said C. S. Pugh for said improvement of said levee be let to and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said C. S. Pugh for the making of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid and the agreement hereinafter mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that work of said improvement shall commence within thirty days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of October, 1912, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time; and that said C. S. Pugh furnish a bond in the sum of two thousand dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditional on the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said C. S. Pugh and further indemnifying the City of Albany against and claiming costs for labor, work or materials on the part of any person arising out of such contract.
