

ORDINANCE NO. 629

Albany, Oregon

Ordinance No. 629
Rep 1926

An ordinance requiring the use of horses, mules or any beast of burden and vehicles propelled by animal power in the City of Albany, Oregon, repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith and providing a penalty for violation thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to ride or cause to be ridden, to drive or cause to be driven, any horse, horses, mules, mules or other beast of burden or any vehicle propelled by animal power on any street, alley or other public way within the corporate limits of the City of Albany at a greater speed than six miles per hour and at no time at a greater rate of speed than is reasonable, having regard to the safety of the public, the traffic, and the use of the street then being traveled.

Section 2. All animals ridden or driven and all vehicles propelled by animal power within the City of Albany shall observe the general rules of the laws of the road, by keeping to the right of the center of street, alley or other public way and when approaching an intersection of a street, alley or other public way with the intention of turning thereat, shall in turning to the right keep closely to the right and in turning to the left shall go to and not beyond the center of the intersection. Whenever an animal ridden or driven or any vehicle driven by animal power is left standing in the street, it shall stand on the side of the street upon which it is required to be driven facing in the direction in which it is required to be driven, and no animal shall be left standing in the street without the same shall be under the control of the rider or driver thereof.

Section 3. Any person, person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court be punished by a fine not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$20.00 or be imprisoned in the city jail not more than five days nor more than ten days.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
