

Ord. No. 622

An Ordinance declaring a surplus on account of street paving by the Warren Construction Company on Sixth Street from the East line of Washington Street to the West curb line of Baker Street, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of Sixth Street heretofore assessed and entered of record in the Book of City Liens in the City of Albany, Oregon for making such improvements, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:-

Section 1. That a surplus of .05913 per cent. is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and the Warren Construction Company, for the improvement of Sixth Street from the East line of Washington Street to the West curb line of Baker Street; and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said Sixth Street heretofore assessed for making such improvements.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Book of City Liens in the surplus column thereof, a credit of .05913 per cent. based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said Sixth Street; said surplus being in favor of the following persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate and in sums as follows, to-wit:-
