An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Jefferson Street from the North line of First Street to the South line of Water Street, prescribing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty of damages to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving to the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City Of Albany Do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Jefferson Street from the North line of First Street to the South line of Water Street, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.

Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with gravel lithubitum paviment.

Third: By laying and constructing gravel lithubitum kerbeds.

Fourth: By constructing catch basins.

Fifth: By constructing sidewalks.

Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvement is to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications are to be made by the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of said Jefferson Street, filed in the office of the City Recorder of said City of Albany on the 2nd day of March, 1913, endorsed: "City Engineer, plans and specifications for the improvement of Jefferson Street from the North line of First Street to the South line of Water Street, and the estimates of the work to be done on said street and the cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said Jefferson Street shall be assessed upon the real property adjacent thereto and especially and particularly specified hereby as provided by the charter of said city.

The improvement of said Jefferson Street shall be completed by the 1st day of July, 1913.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said

street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, corporation or person with whom or with whom any contract may be entered into by said city for the making of said improvement, shall before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient security, in the sum of \$1000<sup>00</sup> for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, corporation or person entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Jefferson Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$5<sup>00</sup> per day, for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

All pavements shall be laid in dry and quiet weather and not otherwise.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said Jefferson Street, by publishing such notice 10 days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Jefferson Street.
