An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving the alley running through Blocks numbered seven (7), eight (8), nine (9) and ten (10), in the City of Albany, Oregon, providing how the costs of such improvements shall be paid, the penalty of its images to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said alley, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvements of said part of said alley.

The People of The City Of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That the alley running through Blocks numbered seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), and ten (10), in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said alley to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the alley full width with gravel bitthulitic pavement.
- Third: By laying wooden pavement stops.
- Fourth: By constructing inlets.
- Fifth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, for the improvement of said alley, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 1913, endorsed: "Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of the alley between First and Second Streets from the West line of Lyon Street to the East line of Washington Street, and the estimates of the work to be done on said alley and the probable costs thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said alley shall be assessed upon the real property adjacent thereto and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of said City.

The improvements of said alley shall be completed by the first day of August, 1913.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said alley deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, corporation or person with which or with whom any contract may be entered into by said city for the making of said

improvements, shall before commencing said improvements, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient security, in the sum of \$250.00 for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, corporation or person entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said alley shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$1.00 per day, for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

All payment shall be laid in dry and suitable weather and not otherwise.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of said alley, by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Democrat, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvements of said alley.
