An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Sixth Street from the West curb line of Baker Street to the west curb line of Jefferson Street, providing now the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty of damages to the City of Albany, by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Sixth Street from the West curb line of Baker Street to the west curb line of Jefferson Street, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.

Second: By paving the roadway of said street, all width, with full intersections, with Trav. Bituminous Pavement.

Third: By laying and constructing Gravel - Bituminous Headers.

Fourth: By constructing cated basins.

Fifth: By constructing inlets.

Sixth: By laying artificied sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimate of the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of said Sixth Street, filed in the office of the City Recorder of said City of Albany on the 14th day of May, 1913, enclosed with Order, plans and specifications for the improvement of Sixth Street, from the west curb line of Baker Street to the west curb line of Jefferson Street, and the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of said Sixth Street at the crossings or intersections to cross by other streets, shall be paid by the City of Albany and the General Fund of said City, the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement of said Sixth Street, will be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessments heretofore made, ascertained and declared by Ordinance No. 602, passed by the Council of said City of Albany, on the 11th day of June, 1913, and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 11th day of June, 1913, on the 1st and part of

lots adjacent to said portion of said Sixth Street to be so improved, and especially and particularly benefitted thereby, as provided by the charter of said City.

The improvement of said Sixth Street shall be completed by the 1st day of August, 1913.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, corporation or person with which no written contract may be entered into by said city for the making of said improvement, shall before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient security, in the sum of \$300,000 for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, corporation or person entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvements of said Sixth Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages by account thereof to the amount of \$10.<sup>00</sup> per day, on each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

All pavements shall be laid in dry and suitable weather and not otherwise.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said Sixth Street by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing all said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Sixth Street.
