An ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined in Resolution No. 26, adopted by said Council on the 2nd day of July, 1913, to make on Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street; to ascertain assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvements of said Hill Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Hill Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said city to enter a statement of such assessments in the closet of city liens as provided by the charter of said city.

Whereas, on the 11th day of June, 1913, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said city to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street in said city by grading said street to the required subgrade and grading said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, twelve feet wide, and for the estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Hill Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said city, said resolution being under Resolution No. 27 and adopted the 11th day of June, 1913; and

Whereas, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution No. 27 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of said Hill Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 27 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said city on the 20th day of June, 1913; and

Whereas, the said city Council on the 2nd day of July, 1913 by Resolution No. 26 duly adopted by said Council determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 26; and

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 26 adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North Curb line of Ninth Street as provided by the charter of said City of Albany; and

Whereas, the Recorder, in pursuance of said order

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and direction of the council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Hill Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and

Whereas, the said council in and by said resolution No. 26, ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Hill Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Hill Street to be improved as mentioned in said Resolution No. 26 to be the sum of \$1448.13 and the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Hill Street to be the sum of \$1329.92;

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Hill Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street shall be improved as follows:

- First. By grading said street to the required subgrade.
- Second. By grading said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, twelve feet wide.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 26 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the City Recorder of said City of Albany on the 20th day of June, 1913.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Hill Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street in the manner heretofore determined by the council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 26 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$1329.92.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Hill Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Hill Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 26 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
