An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the curb line of Fifth Street, providing for the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if said work shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work, also a certificate of title, part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of written notice, which to the completion of such improvement, shall be held, said street.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North Curb line of Fifth Street shall be improved in the following manner, to wit:

First. By grading said street to the required subgrade.
Second. By graveling said street six inches deep with the center stone, three inches deep at the curbsides, to the extent of six inches wide.

Said improvement to commence in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and other laws and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer, for the improvement of Hill Street, filed in the office of the recorder of said City of Albany on the 20th day of August, 1913, endorsed "City Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North Curb line of Fifth Street and the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of said street at the crossings or intersections, and by other streets, shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the General Fund of the City; the remaining portions of the cost of said improvement of said Hill Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessment levied for making, maintaining and repairing by ordinance No. 670 passed by the council of said City of Albany on the 15th day of August, 1913, and also by the Mayor of said City on the 1st day of August, 1913, on the two parts of lots adjacent to said portion of Hill Street to wit, 11th, 12th, 13th, and especially and particularly numbered thereby, as defined by the cadastral map of said city.

ORDINANCE NO. . . .

The improvement of said Hill Street shall be completed by the 15th day of October 1913.

All bids for the making of contracts for the improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City for the making of said improvement, shall before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing of such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety in the sum of two hundred dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 1. If the firm person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make and improve said Hill Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 2. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of Hill Street, by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Hill Street.
