

ORDINANCE NO. 74 ✓

An ordinance declaring a surplus on account
of certain improvements on Sixth Street from the West line of
Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street, and directing the Recorder
of the City of Albany to place the credit of the several owners of the
various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said
portion of Sixth Street to one assessor and entered of record in
the dockets of city taxes in the City of Albany, Oregon, for making such im-
provements, such proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of \$458.75 per cent is hereby ascer-
tained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract
entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and G. W.
Jockeystader for the improvements of Sixth Street from the West
line of Walnut Street to the East line of Elm Street and in favor
of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting
upon and adjacent to said portion of said Sixth Street heretofore
agreed for making such improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby
directed to enter in the Docket of City Taxes with surplus column
thereof, a credit of 0.4587 percent based upon the several amounts re-
corded in the ledger entered to have the cost of the improvement
paid in full, and surplus being in favor of the following named
persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate
and in the sum as follows, to wit:

Section 3. Whereas conditions are such that this ordinance
is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby de-
clared to exist, and this ordinance shall remain in full force and ef-
fect until and after it is approved by the Mayor.
