

Ord 700

An ordinance declaring a surplus in account of the construction of a lateral sewer with S. McLean, through Block 13, across Hill Street through Block 13 to connect with the lateral sewer in the north portion of Block 13 and to be entered in the Recorder of the City of Albany to the credit of the owners of the various parcels of real estate therein, said Block 13 and Hill Street in the north portion of Block 13 and to be entered in the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon in making such improvements, and to be entered in the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon in making such improvements.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of 13.38 per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the improvements thereto by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and S. McLean in the construction of lateral sewer through Block 13 across Hill Street, and through Block 13 to connect with the lateral sewer in the north portion of said Block 13 in the north portion of Block 13 and to be entered in the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, and in the Recorder of the various parcels of real estate therein, said Block 13 and Hill Street in the north portion of Block 13, and to be entered in the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon in making such improvements.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Docket of City claims in the name of the City of Albany, Oregon, a credit of 13.38 per cent, based upon the sewer improvements heretofore assessed and entered therein to be for the cost of improvement of said lateral sewer; said surplus being in favor of the various parcels of real estate therein, and to be entered in the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon in making such improvements.
