

Ord No. 715
An ordinance relating and providing for purchase
of a site upon which to erect a city hall and providing for the amount
to be paid therefor and the manner in which title shall be acquired.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the following described property be and
the same is hereby selected as a site upon which to erect and main-
tain a city hall as authorized by the charter of the City of Albany.

Block Twenty-nine (29) in the City of Albany, Linn County,
Oregon.

Section 2. That there shall be paid for the said
premises given the sum arising from the sale of bonds thereon, the
sum of \$22,000.00.

Section 3. That the provisions hereinbefore set
forth are conditional upon the acceptance of the terms so set, by the
present owner or owners of the premises, which acceptance shall be
in writing by the owner or owners of said premises and shall be
filed with the recorder of the City of Albany within five days after the
approval of this ordinance.

Section 4. That in case of the failure of said ac-
ceptance of the terms herein by the owner or owners of said premises
as hereinbefore provided, the City Attorney shall within five days there-
after examine the abstract of title to said land and make the same
and make report in writing of his opinion concerning the con-
dition of the title to the said premises as so stated by said abstract.
Should the record of title be found to be defective, a reconvey-
and cadastral title can be re-submitted at the same time, a reconvey-
time shall be given said owner or owners to perfect said title.

Section 5. At such time as the City Attorney
reports to the council in writing to them that the title to said premises
is vested in said owner or owners, the city attorney incumbe-
nt upon the City Attorney to record the same in the office
of the recorder of the city of Albany, and to give a full and
satisfactory written certificate of a clear warranty of title
against all persons, all claims and demands of Seattle, in
trust \$6,000.00, in trust \$1,000.00, for expenses, a amount and
as bonds in the amount of \$1,000.00, and the same
in the hands of the City Attorney to pay the said warrant.

Section 6. Pending the payment of the amount
of Council Tax, by the owner or owners, the title to the

10th, 1913, is hereby reenacted.

Section 1. Whereas existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, law and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
