

ORDINANCE NO. 717. ²

An ordinance declaring it unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation to keep, have or store bees, within the limits of the City of Albany and providing a punishment for such offense.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That any person, persons, firm or corporation who shall keep within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, any bees or swarms, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined \$10.00 or more than \$25.00 but not less than \$10.00, or imprisonment in the city jail not less than two nor more than 12 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
