An ordinance declaring it unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation to keep bees or stings of bees within the limits of the City of Albany and providing a punishment for such offense.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That any person or persons, firm or corporation who shall be within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, and be or shall be guilty of a violation of the ordinance and upon conviction thereof by the Recorder's Court shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than two nor more than 12 days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
