727 An ordinance to amend Section 13 of Ordinance 152
 of the City of Alvarado titled "an ordinance concerning offensive
 Rep 1506 disorderly conduct, defining it and making constitutive
 the same and providing for the punishment thereof" passed
 at the City on May 3, 1887, approved by the Mayor May 13, 1887.

The People of the City of Alvarado Do hereby Ordain:

Section 13. That the ordinance of the City of Alvarado titled "an ordinance concerning offensive disorderly conduct, defining it and making it constitutive the same and providing for the punishment thereof" passed the council May 3, 1887, approved by the Mayor May 13, 1887, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 13. That any person or persons who shall between the hours of twelve M. M. and six o'clock in the following morning, make any noise or disturbance so as to disturb the peace or quiet of any respectable family dwelling or place of residence adjacent to where such noise or disturbance is made, or shall be ever in action tried before the Recorder's court, or fined less than five dollars for more than one hundred dollars, and if his or her name in the City shall not be known two days and more than twenty days, or shall be disclosed in the court, who is now for no person shall permit or allow any noise or disturbance to be made or caused except for an emergency! In case of time or time to make the record and quiet of the occupant or occupants of any dwelling office or residence adjacent to where abouts or disturbance is made, or on the 1st day of each month, or on the 1st day of each quarter, to make noise or disturbance in the city or more than twenty dollars, or if his name in the city shall not be known to be tried before the court, or both in case of time of the court, respectively, however, if at time or time to make noise or disturbance in the city or more than twenty dollars, or if his name in the city shall not be known to be tried before the court, or both in case of time of the court, respectively, to determine upon him or disturbance.
