an ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving the alley running through the center of Block Five (5), providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That the alley running through the center of Block Five (5) in the City of Albany shall be improved in the following manner to-wit:

- First: By grading said alley to the proper sub-grade.
- Second: By paving the alley full width with asphaltic concrete or similar pavement.
- Third: By constructing inlets.
- Fourth: By laying sewer pipe.
- Fifth: By tapping sewer.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinance of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of said alley, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the second day of July, 1914, and signed "Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of the alley through the center of Block Five in the City of Albany, and the estimates of the work to be done on said alley and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of said alley shall be paid out of the fund collected and arising upon and out of the assessment hereafter to be made, ascertained and levied on the owners of said city of Albany or the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said alley to be so improved, and especially such portions particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said city.

The said improvement of said portion of said alley shall be completed by the 1st day of November, 1914.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed amendable to the council of the City.

Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City for the making of said improvements shall, before commencing said improvements, and at the time of signing of such contracts, make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvements of said alley shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of said alley by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, and by describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said alley.
