

ORDINANCE NO. 754.

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer, beginning at the west end of lateral sewer constructed through Block 16, across Denver Street, through the center of Block 16, across Cleveland Street and 40 feet into Block 6, all in Hackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, providing how the cost shall be borne, and shall be paid, and the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the persons or persons making such improvement if the same be not completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond on the faithful performance of the work of such improvement and providing for the advertising by the Recorder of said City of Albany of pre-notice for bids for the completion of said improvement.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer beginning at the west end of lateral sewer constructed through Block 16, across Denver Street, through the center of Block 16, across Cleveland Street and 40 feet into Block 6, all in Hackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for construction of said sewer, now in the office of the Recorder, said City of Albany on the 6th day of August, 1907, endorsed "Engineering Plans and Specifications of lateral sewer connecting Cleveland Street beyond Church in the City of Albany, Oregon."

"West end of lateral sewer from Denver Street and across Cleveland Street and 40 feet into the City of Albany and the 40 feet from the west end of said lateral sewer to the east end of said lateral sewer, all costs and expenses connected therewith arising out of the work, and all materials and labor used and expended by the city and parts of the adjacent to said improvement and to be made and expended in a peculiarly trifling manner as provided by the Charter of the city."

The said sewer shall be completed in the 1st day of December 1907.

All bids for the making of said improvement, deemed unreasonable by the council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

No firm person or corporation with whom a contract has been made shall be allowed to make any improvement

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and before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing of such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city, a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the sum of two hundred dollars for the just fulfil performance of said contract.

Section 2. If the first, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement and not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said city is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said city of Albany, briefly describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
