 corner, continuing a lateral sewer, which the council of the City of
 Albany directs, also determined by Resolution No. 33 adopted by
 the council on the 2nd day of September, 1914, requiring at the sewer on
 the West side of Block 11, in Hargraves Addition to the City of
 Albany, Oregon, as running thence Northly across Lafayette Street to
 and thence thence thence across the center of Block 11, in Hargraves
 Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 221 feet, to certain,
 accuracy of the plan and to be the proportionate sum of such
 probable cost, such improvement that is assessed for each lot
 in part thereof, adjacent to said improvement to direct the Recorder of
 said city to enter a statement of such assessments in the Book of
 Assessments as provided by the Charter of said City.

Whereas on the 1st day of October, of 1914, the council of the
 City of Albany duly adopted a resolution requiring the City En-
 gineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the con-
 struction of a lateral sewer beginning at the sewer on the West
 side of Block 11, in Hargraves Addition to the City of Albany,
 Oregon, running thence Northly across Lafayette Street and thence
 Westly along the center of Block 11, in Hargraves Addition to the
 City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 221 feet, and so the estimate
 of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof and requiring
 said engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost to be
 filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on said September
 1, 1914, and by the executive branch adopted "Resolution
 No. 33 adopted Sept. 1st, 1914" and

Whereas the City Engineer of the City of Albany,
 pursuant to said resolution No. 33, made plans, specifications
 and estimates as directed and said Resolution further commanding
 of said sewer in the manner specified in said Resolution,
 and said said plans, specifications and estimates in the
 Recorder's office in said city on the 7th day of September, 1914;

Whereas the said city council on the 9th day of Septem-
 ber, 1914, by Resolution No. 33, after adopting said Resolution,
 determined and resolved that it was not sufficient and that
 said council proposed to contract said sewer over re-
 gressing at the sewer on the West side of Block 11, in Harg-
 raves Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, running thence
 Northly across Lafayette Street and thence thence along the
 center of Block 11, in Hargraves Addition to the City of Albany,
 Oregon, a distance of 221 feet, and upon that the recorder of

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city of Albany; and

Whereas the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said city of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and

Whereas the said council in and by said Resolution No. 32 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said improvement as mentioned in said Resolution No. 32 to be the sum of \$1,700.00 and the total probable costs of making said improvement to be \$223.58.

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That an eight inch vitrified terra cotta lateral sewer shall be laid running at the sewer on the West side of Block No. 122 in Hackerman's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, running thence Westerly across Lafayette Street and thence Westerly along the center of Block 117 in Hackerman's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 221 feet.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 32 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 9th day of Sept. 914.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner aforesaid determined by the council of said city of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 32 is hereby levied to be the sum of \$223.58 and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the property adjacent, and especially and particularly specified thereby is the sum of \$1,700.00.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement as aforesaid upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said council in and by said Resolution No. 32 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof as follows:
