

Lawling Albany Oregon

An ordinance to ascertain, determine and declare the cost of constructing a cement sidewalk on the South side and adjacent to the Southeast quarter of Block 62 in the City of Albany Oregon and to assess said cost and establish a lien upon said land and directing said lien to be entered in the books of City records.

Whereas on the 7th day of October, 1914, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Albany reported to the council that sidewalk should be built on North West side of and adjacent to the Southeast quarter of Block 62 in the City of Albany, Oregon; and

Whereas the council on said 7th day of October, 1914, duly passed Resolution No. 37, ordering said sidewalk constructed within twenty days on said October 7th, 1914, which resolution specified the said location, the material to be used and that the construction should be in accordance with Ordinance No. 468; and

Whereas within five days after the said order to build sidewalk on October 7th, 1914, the Superintendent of Streets did post a notice upon said Southeast quarter of Block 62 in the City of Albany, Oregon, adjacent to the sidewalk ordered to be built, headed "Notice to Build Sidewalk" in letters not less than one-half inch in length and which said notice in legible characters, directed to the owner of said property C. W. Strong to build said sidewalk within twenty days from said October 7th, 1914; and

Whereas the Superintendent of Streets filed with the Recorder an affidavit of the posting of such notice, stating the date, time and the place where the same was posted; and

Whereas the Recorder filed this five days from said order of October 7, 1914, and by mail a notice to build said sidewalk to the owner of said property, C. W. Strong, directed to the post office address of such owner, to-wit: 22, Duane Street, Oregon; and

Whereas the owner of said Southeast quarter of Block 62, in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: C. W. Strong, failed, neglected and refused to build such sidewalk within the time ordered by the council; and

Whereas the Superintendent of Streets has built said sidewalk and kept an accurate account of the cost of labor and material in building said sidewalk adjacent to said land above described and has reported as owner is compelled to pay the cost of said sidewalk together with a description of the lot or part thereof, upon which said sidewalk was built upon which said sidewalk was built; and

Whereas the council has inspected the said report of the Superintendent of Streets and the construction of said sidewalk and the cost thereof, which cost is the sum of \$13,77.00

Whereas the council has also determined that the same to be

ordinance is hereby approved.

Therefore:

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the cost of building the sidewalk on Ninth Street on the South side of, and adjacent to the Southeast quarter of Block 62, in the City of Albany, Oregon, was and is the sum of \$76.77.

Section 2. That there be and there is hereby assessed upon the said Southeast quarter of Block 62 in the City of Albany, Oregon, for said sidewalk construction the sum of \$76.77 and that the same be and is hereby made a lien upon said premises until the full payment thereof, and the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately make a statement of the said assessment and lien together with the name of the owner of said Southeast quarter of Block 62 in the City of Albany, Oregon, B. V. Strong, in the pocket of City liens of the City of Albany as provided by the charter of said city, and that the Recorder said forthwith give notice in writing as provided in Section 223 of the Charter of the City of Albany to the owner or reputed owner of said real property.
