

An ordinance to an Ordinance No. 102, entitled "An ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same and providing for the punishment thereof," passed by the Council, May 21, 1887, and approved by the Mayor, May 13, 1887.

The same is hereby amended as follows:

That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 102, entitled "An ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same and providing for the punishment thereof," passed by the Council, May 21, 1887, and approved by the Mayor, May 13, 1887, to and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Any person who shall hitch or fasten any horse, mare, or mule, or any animal to any fixed object located in or upon any street, avenue, gallery or public place in the City of Albany shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, be fined not exceeding twenty dollars or imprisoned in the City jail not more than ten days, or both at the discretion of the court, except that the hitching of any animal to a tree, fence or any other object by the City of Albany or to private hitching places with the consent of the owner of such private hitching places shall not be construed to be a violation of this section.
