

The Ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of construction of a lateral sewer, which the Council of the City of Evans, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 10, adopted by the Council on the 24th day of March, 1914, and approved by the Mayor on the 24th day of March, 1914, beginning at the manhole in Henry Street in said sewer, at the intersection of said Henry Street with the first street extended in compliance with Ordinance of the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly across Henry Street, and through lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 78, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100, and running thence westerly between lots 31 and 32, across Spencer Street and along the line between lots 40 and 41, Block 12, said Bryant's Addition, a distance of 290 feet to the northwest corner of said lot 47, thence northerly along the town line between Bryant's Addition and Bryant's Second Addition a distance of 330 feet to a point near the northern boundary line of said Bryant's Addition and Bryant's Second Addition, thence northerly to the northwesterly corner of said lot 47, said Block 12, and running thence northerly along the town line between said Bryant's Addition and Bryant's Second Addition to a point near the northern boundary line of said Henry Street, and in the City of Albany, Oregon, and being a total distance of 1044 feet, and to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the approximate value of such a probable work of such improvement, and that it is assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, or parcel, and adjacent to such improvement, to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the books of said City as provided by the Charter of said City.

Whereas, the Council in pursuance of the directions of the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, made plans, specifications and estimates for the construction of the above described lateral sewer, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, on the 13th day of March, 1914, and

Whereas, the Council on the 24th day of March, 1914, by Resolution No. 10, and a copy of said Council Resolution is on file in the office of the Recorder of said City, determined and

to construct the above described lateral sewer, and  
Whereas, by said Resolution No. 1, adopted as  
aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered  
and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed sewer  
improvement as provided by the Charter of the City of Albany, and

Whereas, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and  
direction of the Council of said City, has duly given notice of said  
proposed sewer improvement in the manner provided by the Charter of said City,  
and

Whereas, the said Council in and by said Resolution, No. 1,  
has ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said  
improvement to be six hundred and thirty dollars and no part of said  
improvement as mentioned in said Resolution No. 1 to be the sum of  
\$132.86, and the total probable cost of making said improvement to be  
\$1692.37.

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany's Ordinance is Follows:

Section 1. That an eight inch vitreous terra cotta sewer  
shall be laid in a trench in the main line of sewer street between  
said streets, at the intersection of said street with the First Street  
in Brown's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence  
westwardly across Pearl Street between lots 6 and 7 of Block 1 of said  
addition to the City of Albany, a distance of 138 feet to the northwesterly  
corner of Lot 7 of said second addition, thence northwardly along the center line  
of said Block 1 a distance of 250 feet; also beginning at said northwesterly  
corner of said Lot 7 in said second addition and running southwardly along the  
center line of said street a distance of 63 feet to a point near the  
northwesterly corner of Plantation Street; Also beginning at a point where the  
aforesaid lateral sewer intersects the corner of Lots 10, 11, and 12,  
in said Block 1 and running thence westwardly between lots 31 and 32,  
across Henry Street and along the line between Lots 48 and 49 of Block  
12 of said second addition, a distance of 77 feet to the northwest corner  
of said Lot 49; thence northwardly along the boundary line between Brown's  
Addition and said second addition a distance of 55 feet to a point  
near the northwesterly corner of said Brown's Addition and Brown's  
Second Addition, also beginning at the northwesterly corner of Lot 49  
of said Block 12 and running southwardly along the boundary line  
between said second addition and said second addition, a distance of 120 feet  
to a point near the northwesterly corner of Plantation Street, a distance  
of 120 feet, and then running a straight line of 170 feet, to a point

and into said plane and specifications of said improvement  
made by the City Engineer with the approval of the City Council on the  
31st day of May, 1914.

Section 1. That the probable cost of making said im-  
provement in the several lots are determined by the Council of said  
City. The taxes in and on said Resolution no. 1 is hereby declared to be the  
share of \$148.00, and the several cost of said improvement to be paid by  
the property adjacent and the parties and particularly benefited  
thereby in the sum of \$1632.66.

Section 2. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of  
said improvement assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to  
said improvement as a, assessed and as determined by the Council  
in and by said Resolution 1, is hereby assessed and deter-  
mined to be the amount and based immediately after the separate  
description of each of said lots or parts thereof.
