

Kawling, Albany, Oregon

An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer main in the name of in Cook Street sewer between Union and First Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly across said Street and thence to the center of Block 8 of Harrison and Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and to extend north to the east line of Sherman Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 212 feet, providing that the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the price to be loaned to the City of Albany by the people of persons owning such improvement at the time of completion of the same, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving of notice to the Recorder, said City of Albany of proper notice for bids for the construction of said improvement.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight inch vitri-fied terra cotta sewer main in the name of in Cook Street sewer between Union and First Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly across said Street and thence to the center of Block 8 of Harrison and Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and to extend north to the east line of Sherman Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 212 feet.

and improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City in the construction of such lateral sewer main in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 15th day of August 1915.

The cost of such improvement shall be paid out of the funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the amount to be made ascertained and determined by the City Engineer of said City in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 15th day of August 1915.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of August 1915.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed necessary made by the City of Albany, Oregon, on or after the 15th day of August 1915, and received in accordance with the provisions of the charter of said City of Albany, Oregon, shall be void.

... and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the sum of \$1000 for the faithful performance of said contract.

Section 2. Any person or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement shall not contract the same until the time mentioned and specified in said contract, and said person is bound to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$1.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in said contract, which amount shall be paid by said contractor when the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said city is hereby directed to immediately give public notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Democrat & daily newspaper published in said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
