

An Ordinance providing for the laying and maintenance of improving of Main Street from the south line of Water Street to the south line of Fourth Street, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damages to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice or bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Main street from the south line of Water Street to the south line of Fourth Street shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with asphaltic concrete pavements or an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third: By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete headers.
- Fourth: By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth: By constructing inlets.
- Sixth: By laying reinforced sewer pipe.
- Seventh: By laying sub-drain tile.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, in manner & cost, certified in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, no 500, 28th day of April, 1906, endorsed "Engineering and Specifications for the improvement of Main Street from the south line of Water Street to the south line of Fourth Street and the cost of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of Main Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of land adjacent to said portion of said Main Street so to be improved, and especially and particularly levied thereon as provided in the charter

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The said improvement of said portion of said Main Street shall be completed by the 20th day of October, 1870.

No bids for the making of said improvement of said street shall be received after the 15th day of October, 1870, and if any bid or bids so received are unacceptable to the Councils of the City of Albany may be rejected.

No person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement, bind at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient sureties in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. No person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Main Street shall not complete to the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said city shall be entitled to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid to the contractor for the work at the completion thereof unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Councils.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice of bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of said Main Street by publishing an advertisement to the best in the Albany Daily Democrat, calling on all other newspapers in the said City of Albany, fully describing in detail the said work and an award doing the work of said improvement to the said Main Street.
