

an ordinance providing for the time and manner of  
 building a sewer connecting a water house beginning at the manhole  
 in Terry Street which runs a line some contents with Twelfth Street  
 and running thence easterly along said Twelfth Street parallel with  
 and eight feet from the center line thereof 150 feet to the intersection  
 with the center line of the alley through Block 4 Central Addition;  
 thence easterly along the center line of said alley and the extension  
 thereof 250 feet to a point in the street or road running northwesterly  
 and southeasterly as it is at present on the northwesterly side thereof, thence  
 southeasterly along said street or road parallel with and eight feet  
 from the northwesterly side thereof 200 feet, and being a total distance of  
 400 feet; providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid; the  
 penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or  
 persons making such improvement if the same is not completed within  
 the time specified upon, and in giving by the Recorder of said City of Albany  
 of proper notice for bids for the completion of said improvement.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight inch  
 lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in Terry Street trunk  
 sewer where same connects with Twelfth Street and running thence  
 easterly along said Twelfth Street, a width with and eight feet from the  
 center line thereof 150 feet to the intersection with the center line of the  
 alley through Block 4 Central Addition, thence southeasterly along the center  
 line of said alley and the extension thereof 250 feet to a point in the street  
 or road running southeasterly and northerly and eight feet from the northwesterly  
 side thereof 200 feet, and being a total distance of 400 feet, and the  
 cost of such improvement shall be made in accordance with the  
 charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the provisions, specifications  
 and estimates of the City Engineer, which are on file in the office of  
 the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 25th day of April, 1915.

The cost of said sewer shall be paid out of the funds  
 collected and arising out of the assessments to be made, ascertainable  
 and declared by the City Engineer in the rate and parts of rate ad valorem, to said  
 improvement, to be made and levied upon and paid therefor by the property benefited  
 thereby as provided in the charter of said City.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 10th day of August,

1915.

and with the making of said improvement.

Sealing: Albany, Oregon

reasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Every person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the city for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time it is in such contract, make, receive and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the sum of \$100.00 or the full value of said contract.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages as a result thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said city is hereby directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice for ten days in the Albany Herald, a daily newspaper published in said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
