

for Ordinance to amend Section 14 of Ordinance No. 141 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses" approved February 10th, 1886, to repeal Ordinance No. 817 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax, and regulate billiard rooms and pool-rooms, and to repeal" and to amend Section 14 of Ordinance No. 141 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses", approved February 10th, 1886, as relates to billiard and pool-rooms; also Ordinance No. 826, approved March 26, 1897, and to repeal the same; and to amend Section 14 of Ordinance No. 141 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate billiard rooms, and pool-rooms, and to repeal so much of Section 14 of Ordinance No. 141 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses" approved February 10th, 1886, as relates to billiard and pool-rooms; approved March 26, 1897.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Section 14 of Ordinance No. 141 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses" approved February 10th, 1886, be amended to read as follows:

Section 14. The owner or keeper of any bowling alley, shall pay a quarterly license of \$2.50 for each alley belonging to or used in the building or place to be licensed. Every place or building where bowls or balls are thrown shall be regarded as a bowling alley under this ordinance.

The owner or keeper of any billiard room or pool-room shall pay a quarterly license of \$2.50 for each table belonging to or used in the building or place to be licensed. Every place or building where billiards, pool, pigeon-hole or other games are played where balls and cues are used shall be regarded as a billiard-room or pool-room under this ordinance.

Section 2. The ordinance No. 817 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate billiard rooms and pool-rooms, and to repeal so much of Section 14 of Ordinance No. 141 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses" approved February 10th, 1886, as relates to billiard and pool-rooms", approved March 26, 1897, and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The ordinance No. 826 entitled "An
