

ORDINANCE No. 819 ✓

Rawlings, Albany, Oregon

No. Ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 21, aforesaid to said Council in the 12th day of May, 1915, to make on Pine Street from the south line of Salina Road to the north line of Santiam Road; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said Street to be assessed upon each lot as per the amount to said lot of Pine Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Book of City Liens as provided by the charter of said City.

Whereas, on the 24th day of March, 1915, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Pine Street from the south line of Salina Road to the north line of Santiam Road in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the required grade and subgrade.

Second: By gravelizing said street six inches deep and six feet wide,

and for estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Pine Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and the probable cost to be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Be it so" and adopted on the 24th day of March, 1915; and

Whereas, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 21, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the improvement of said Pine Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 21, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said City on the 22nd day of May, 1915; and

Whereas, the said Council on the 12th day of May, 1915, by Resolution No. 21, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve Pine Street from the south line of Salina Road to the north line of Santiam Road in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 21; and

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 21, adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Pine Street from the south line of Salina Road to the north line

of Santiam Road as provided by the charter of said City; and

Whereas, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Pine Street in the manner provided by the charter of said City, and

Whereas, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 21 ascertained and determined the total cost of making said improvement, said Pine Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Pine Street to be imposed as specified in said Resolution No. 21 to be the sum of \$175.00.

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Pine Street in the City of Albany, running from the south line of Salem Road to the north line of Santiam Road shall be improved as follows:

First. By grading said street to the required grade and subgrade.

Second. By grading said street nine inches deep and eight feet wide.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 21 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 12th day of May, 1905.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Pine Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the south line of Salem Road to the north line of Santiam Road, in the manner hereinabove determined by the Council of the said City of Albany in and by said resolution No. 21 to be paid out of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Pine Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$175.00.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Pine Street, an equal upon each owner thereof, adjacent to said part of Pine Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by the Council in and by said Resolution No. 21 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the amount and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts of lots as follows:
