

An Ordinance declaring a surplus on account of the construction of a lateral sewer by W. D. Weaver and G. M. Junkins beginning at the manhole in Oak Street trunk sewer, midway between Seventh and Eighth Streets, and running thence easterly across Block 1, across Pine Street, and 168 feet into Block 2, all in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvements, hereto, one assessed and entered of record in the books of City Sines in the City of Albany, Oregon, for making such improvements, their proportionate shares, such surpluses, and recalling certain assessments which were made and entered of record in the books of City Sines in the City of Albany, Oregon, for making such improvements.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of 11.341 percent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and W. D. Weaver and G. M. Junkins for the construction of a lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in Oak Street trunk sewer, midway between Seventh and Eighth Streets, and running thence easterly across Block 1 across Pine Street, and 168 feet into Block 2, all in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement hereto be assessed for making such improvements.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the books of City Sines in the surplus column thereof a credit of 11.341 percent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said lateral sewer; said surplus shall be in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such parcels of real estate and in sums as follows, to-wit:

Section 3. That the Recorder of the City of Albany be and he is hereby directed to cancel the assessments heretofore made against W. B. Hackleman and Edward Winterstein so far as the same covers the West 36 feet of Lot 12, in Block 2, in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, amounting to \$1.06 and also the assessment heretofore made against D. B. Hackleman so far as the same covers the West 36 feet of Lot 3, in Block 2 in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon.
