

An Ordinance to amend section 88 of Ordinance No. 633 entitled, "An Ordinance regulating the construction, erection, raising, lowering, alterations, repair and use of buildings and to provide for protection against fire and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance," Passed by the Council April 28, 1913 and approved by the Mayor April 28, 1913, and to declare an emergency.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Section 88 of Ordinance No. 633 entitled, "An Ordinance regulating the construction, erection, raising, lowering, alterations, repair and use of buildings and to provide for protection against fire and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance," Passed by the Council April 28, 1913 and approved by the Mayor, April 28, 1913, be amended to read as follows:

Section 88. No person shall kindle or use, or cause to be kindled or used, any fire upon a public street or highway within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, or upon any vacant lot or open space within the fire limits of the City of Albany, without first obtaining a written permit to do so, signed by the Chief of the Fire Department; but this section shall not include fires in furnaces used in heating tar and pitch in the construction or repair of street improvements.

Section 2. Whereas existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health and safety and an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
