

ORDINANCE No. 157

An Ordinance respecting the making of flying switches and the kicking of cars and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. Owners, persons, firms or corporations having charge of the making of any railroad car, within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, will, when engaged in the making of any flying switch or in moving any such cars by the process commonly called kicking, and before any such car is so un-ted or kicked, station a competent person at each street intersection which such car may cross to warn traffic upon said street of the appearance of such car.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$30.00 or be imprisoned in the City jail not less than two nor more than twenty-five days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
