

Any ordinance to license, tax and regulate fortune-telling, clairvoyance, palmistry and handreading and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Section 1. Every person who has engaged in the business, occupation, profession or vocation of fortune-telling, clairvoyance, palmistry or any business, occupation, profession or vocation of like nature, shall first obtain from the City of Albany a license therefor; provided that the fee required from every person or such license shall be the sum of \$1.00 per week or the sum of \$2.50 per day.

Section 2. That if any person or persons exercising or carrying on any business, profession, occupation or vocation for which a license is required by this ordinance without first taking out such license as herein required, or violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, he, she or they shall on conviction thereof before the City Recorder, for every such offense be liable to the punishment of the license, be subjected to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail for a period of not less than two days nor more than 12 days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 3. Whereas this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
