ORDINANCE NO. 391

In the City of Albany Section One of Section Two
of Chapter No. 473 of the City of Albany, passed the Council December
29, 1908, and approved by the Mayor December 30, 1908.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Finance No. 471 of the City of Albany, passed the Council December 29, 1908, and approved by the Mayor December 30, 1908, is and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. That no person or persons shall be permitted to sell, barter, give away or otherwise dispose of any spirituous or vicious liquors that are not intoxicating within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2. That Section 2 of said Ordinance No. 473, passed by the Council December 29, 1908, and approved by the Mayor December 30, 1908, is and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 2. That every person who sells, barter, gives away or otherwise disposes of any spirituous or vicious liquors that are not intoxicating within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said city be punished by a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00 or be imprisoned in the city jail not less than 20 days nor more than 60 days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. Each and every selling, bartering, giving away or otherwise disposing of any spirituous or vicious liquors that are not intoxicating within the corporate limits of the City of Albany shall constitute a separate and distinct violation of the provisions of this ordinance and the person or persons guilty thereof shall upon conviction before the Recorder's Court be punished as in this section provided, however, that the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to druggists who sell such liquor for medical purposes only.
