

An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving First Street from the east line of Main Street to the west curb line of Sherman Street, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That First Street from the east line of Main Street to the west curb line of Sherman Street shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third: By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete headers.
- Fourth: By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth: By constructing inlets.
- Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Civil improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, for the improvement of said street, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon, on the 1st day of August, 1915; endorsed "Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of First Street from the east line of Main Street to the west curb line of Sherman Street under the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of First Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said first street so to be improved, and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of said city.

The said improvement of said portion of said First Street

shall be counted on the 1st day of August, 1916.

All bids for the making of said improvements of said First Street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvements and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance of said contract.

**Section 2.** If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said First Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

**Section 3.** The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of said First Street by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing all said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said First Street.
