ORDINANCE NO.

AN DEPLIANCE AUTHORIZING ALL DIRECTING THE "AYOR AND THOUSING OF THE CITY OF ALLANY, ORMOOD, TO BUTHE LUTO A CONTRACT WITH ORWING ERRYTCE FOR THE COTY OF ALPARY FIRE A THEY OF THE YEARS.

THE PROFILE OF THE CITY OF ALRAITY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Bection 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the Sity of Albany, Oregon be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into the written contract hereinafter set out in the mane of the Sity of Albany, Oregon, with Oregon lower Sompany, a corporation, for electric lighting and water service for said Sity of Albany for a term of five years from the date of the execution thereof, which said written contract shall be executed in behalf of the Sity by the Mayor and Recorder immediately upon this ordinance being in effect and shall be dated as of the date of its execution and be substantially in words and figures as follows, to-wit;

of January, 1916, by and between the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, a municipal corporation harinafter called the City, and Oregon Fower Company, a corporation, duly incorporated and organized under the laws of the State of Oregon, her inafter called the Company.

Witnessath,

1. That the Company hereby agrees to furnish electric lighting and water service to the said City for the term commencing with the date of the execution of this agreement and ending on the 15th day of January 1921 and the City agrees to take said electric lighting and water service for the said term and pay the compensation therefor as hereinafter specified.

No. 415), Salem Road and Pennywinhle bridge, and Santian road approximately No. 415), Salem Road and Pennywinhle bridge, and Santian road approximately one-half way between Main Street and Pailroad crossin, on Seventh Street approximately 290 feet West of Elm Street, and on Eighth Street approximately 290 feet west of Nla Street and at twenty-one additional street interesections in the Sity of Alban, to be designated by the Sity upon the exedution of this contract, the Sompany shall install and maintain at its own expense one 100 candle-power, 5.3 mapers, series, alternating curre t, incondescent electric lamp, with hood and radial wave reflector to be placed on mast area twelve feet in length and at a height of twenty two feet in the clear from the surface of the street, said lemps being hereinafter designated as 100 candle-power lamps.

- 3. At each of the following street intersections in the City of Albany, to-wit: First and Washigton Streets, Tirst and Perry Streets, First and Broadalbin Streets, First and Ellsworth Etreets, First and Lyon Streets, Second and Ferry Streets, Decond and Broadalbin Streets, Second and Ellsworth Streets, Second and Lyon Streets, Third and Lyon Streets, Fourth and Lyon Streets, Fifth and Lyon Streets, Sixth and Lyon Streets, Beventh and Lyon Streets, Eighth ad Lyon Streets, Winth and Lyon Streets, the Company shall install and maintain at its own expense one 600 candle-power, 6.8 ampere, secies, alternating corrent, incondescent lamp, said lamps being hereinafter designated as 600 candle-power lamps.
- 4. The Company also serves to furnish electric service for three 16 candle-power lasps for the City Seconder's Office and five 16 candle-power lasps for the City Council Chambers, the lasps to be furnished and maintained by the fity and burner only when needed.
- 5. The Coupany agrees to furnsin the electric, for and maintain the 100 candle-power large specified in subdivision 2 and for the 600 candle-power incandescent large specified in subdivision 3, and the current for the 16 candle-power large specified in subdivision 4 herein, at and f for the flat rate of Three Hundred Highty six dollars and eighty five cents (\$383.85) per bonth, which sum the City havet, agrees to any the Company for each lighting services aforesaid, the same to be paid promptly each wonth and during the mouth in which said service was furnished.

6. The Company also agrees to f which electric current during the term of this agreement for the following large in the fire house in said City of Alegan, located as follows: Empire House No.1, hall three located experience only when half is

in actual use; Engine house No.2, second floor, three 15 candle-power lamps to be used only when hall is in actual use; Engine house No.2, four 15 candle-power lamps, all night service, and one 16 candle power lamps in bedroom; Chemical Engine Company, one 15 candle-power, all night service; it is understood however, that the City shall furnish at its own cost and expense the lamps provided for in this subdivision; it is understood the service provided for in this subdivision is furnished by the Company to the City under the terms and requirements of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 168 of the City of Albany, the said Company being the assignee of the franchise in said ordinance and now operating thereunder.

- desires other lamps at Street intersections located within the City limits, the Company will place and instal' the same within a reasonable time after notice; provided none of such lamps shall be located more than one City block distant from the Company's circuit or wires supplying service to the City street lamps, and after such additional lamps shall be placed and service commanded the City agrees to pay the Company for such additional lamps the sum of One dollar and eighty three cents (\$1.83) per month for the 100 candle-power lamps and Five dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50) per lamp per month for the 600 candle-power lamps, the same to be payable monthly as provided above in case of the other lamps specified in this contract, and it is expressly agreed and understood that the Company shall not be required to install and maintain any such additional lamps during the last six months of this contract.
- 8. It is understood and agreed that in furnishing the service called for by this contract the Company will use the wires, poles, equipment and machinery it now has installed and in operation in the Sity of Albany, together with such additional wiring, poles, equipment and machinery as the Company may find necessary in furnishing the service in this contrat provided for.
- 3. It is understood and agreed that none of the street lamps at present installed, nor any additional street lamps ordered in by the dity shall be discontinued by the dity during the term of this contract, now the location thereof be changed by the dity without the City paying the Opppany the reasonable expense of such change.

at which locations are at present installed fire cisterns, to-wit;

Second and Baker Streets, Third and Main Streets, Fourth and Contgonery
Streets, Fourth and Ellsworth Streets, Fourth and Washington Streets,
Beyonth and Elm Streets, the Company agrees to supply water service
for such fire cisteres at a monthly rate of One dollar (\$1.00) each.

12. As a part of the consideration for the City taking and paying for the hydrant and cistern service mentioned in subdivisions 10 and 11 hereintefore, the Company agrees to furnish water service for the public watering thoughs at prepent installed, to-wit; at Main and Third Streets and Washington and Second Streets, Provided however that the City shall maintain said watering troughs and keep the same in good repair.

13. The Company agrees to furnish water service to one City street flusher in use at the time of the exedution of this contract, at a monthly rate of (\$40.00 and will also furnish service to any additional similar street flusher at a contally rate of \$40.00 each, and to any flushers of larger capacity at such an increase in rate as will be proportionate to the increased capacity of such flushers.

14. The Company also acrees to install and maintain any additional fire hydrants required by the City at a conthly rate of \$2.00 per hydrant. All additional fire hydrants intalled are to be what is known is known as two-way hore connections and stender mozzle type hydrant.

- and service to all fire disterns which hereafter be constructed by the City and located on the Company's mains, and that the City will take and pay for same at the rate of \$1.00 per month for each of said disterns during the term of this contract; provided, however, that all disterns servied by the Company shall be maintained and kept in good repair by the Sity.
- 16. It is further agreed that the Company shall not be required to install any five hydrant or against on any street or streets where it has a main less than four inches in diameter installed at the time such request is made for such fire hydrant or hydrants; or in any event to extent its mains nove than one city block to serve any additional fire hydrants, except, however the Company agrees to lay a water main of not less than four inches in diameter along Tenth Street from Walnut Street to Cottage Street within six months from the execution of this contract.
- 17. It is also agreed that none of the fire hydrants howe inbove provided for nor such additional ones as may be ordered in shall be discontinued by the Sity during the term of this contract now the locations thereof be changed without the city paying the Sompany the reasonable expense of making such change.
- will use reasonable diligence upon notification at its power house of such fire to increase the pressure in its mains during such fire as much as may be permissable in order to increase the fire hydrent service during such fire, and the Company hereby guarantess a pressure of not less than eighty (90) pounds at the fire hydrent located at second and Broadaloin Streets, and not less than sixty (80) pounds at the fire hydrant located at provided that the Company shall not be liable for damages occasioned by failure to provide or maintain such pressure as a result of breakdown of equipment or for any cause beyond the Company's control.
 - 19. It is acreed that the Jompany shall not be required to install or maintain additional fire hydrants during the last six conths of this content.
 - 20. It is furthe agreed between the parties that all bills in connection with this contract shall be paid monthly by a warrant drawn on the general fund of the City.
 - 21. In consideration of this contract the Company agraes to do and perform all of the terms and conditions on its part to be performed as hereinbefore set forth and the City, in consideration thereof, agrees to do and perform all of the takings on its part to be performed and pay the compensation therefore as hereinbefore set forth.
