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ORDINANCE No. 353

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON HAS DETERMINED IN RESOLUTION NO., 33 ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL, ON THE 10TH DAY OF NOVEMBER 1915 TO MAKE ON WASHINGTON STREET FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF NINTH STREET TO THE NORTH CURB LINE OF THIRTEENTH STREET; TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID WASHINGTON STREET THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID PART OF SAID WASHINGTON STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED; TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF THE CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF THE SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 11th day of August 1915 the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Washington Street from the South line of Ninth Street to the North curb line of Thirteenth Street in the following manner to-wit:

- First. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second. By paving the roadway of said Street full width with full intersections, with asphalt concrete pavement on a asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third. By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete headings.
- Fourth. By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth. By constructing inlets.
- Sixth. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

and for estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Washington Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates, and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. 26", and adopted the 11th day of August 1915.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 26 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said Washington Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No., 26 and filed said plans specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said City on the 10th day of November, 1915.

WHEREAS the said Council on the 10th day of November 1915 by Resolution No., 33 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve Washington Street from the south line of Ninth Street to the north curb line of Thirteenth Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No., 33; and

WHEREAS, in and by said resolution No., 33 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Washington Street from the south line of Ninth Street to the north curb line of Thirteenth Street as provided by the Charter of said City; and

WHEREAS the recorder in pursuance of said order and direction

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of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Washington Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

WHEREAS the said Council in and by the said Resolution No., 33 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of Said Washington Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Washington Street to be improved as specified in the said Resolution No., 33 to be the sum of \$7439.93.

## T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Washington Street in the City of Albany, Oregon from the south line of Ninth Street to the north curb line of Thirteenth Street, shall be improved as follows:

- First. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second. By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections, with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third. By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete headings.
- Fourth. By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth. By constructing inlets.
- Sixth. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

all in accordance with said Resolution no. 33 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 10th day of November 1915.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Washington Street in the City of Albany from the south line of Ninth Street to the north curb line of Thirteenth Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by Resolution No. 33 with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement to be paid ~~and~~ by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Washington Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$7489.93.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Washington Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Washington Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 33 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
