

AN OADINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON TO ENTER THTO A CONTRACT WITH J. W. THAVIS, FOR THE LIDROVE-MENT OF FIRST STREET FROM THE EAST LINE OF MAIN STREET TO THE WEST CURB LINE OF SHERMAN " STREET.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. A52 of the City of Albany, Oregon it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: First Street from the East line of Main Street to the West ourb line of Sherman Street, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

by grading said street to the proper subgrade. By paving the rondway of said street full width with full intersections with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation. Second.

By laying indecember tounaction.
By constructing each busine.
By constructing inlets.
By laying vitrified sewer pipe. Third.

said improvement to be made in accordance with the plans, specifi cations and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the accorder of the

WHEREAS it is provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the taking of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Lecorder of the City of Albany according to law and the Ordinace last aforesaid, to-wit: on the 22nd day of March 1916, J. W. Travis, presented to the Council of the City of Albany, his bid for making said improvement with asphaltic Concrete Pavement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council by which said bid, J. W. Travis proposed to furnish all the material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with asphaltic Concrete Pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:.

> Excavation, per cubic yard----- .65 Fill or embankment, per cubic yard ----\$.25 Asphaltic Concrete Surface, including the surface finishing corse and the foundation complete, per square yard Six inch sewer pipe, per lineal foot ----- 3 .50 Paving headers, per lineal foot----- 30 Monuments, each-----Tapping lateral and main sower-------

AND WHERE'S, said . W. Travis was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and eaid bid was the lowest and best bid therefor,

Section 1. That the bid of J. W. Travis for said improvement of said described portion of First Street with Asphaltic Concrete Payeaent be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and accorder

of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with said J. W. Travis for the making of said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Parament on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of August 1916, unless time be extended by said Council, and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the said work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said J. W. Travis furnish a bond in the sum of \$750.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as surety some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of J. W. Travis, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lein for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising our of said contract.
