

ORDINANCE NO. 868

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE AUDITING OF THE BOOKS, ACCOUNTS AND RECORDS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That at the beginning of each regular term of office of the recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, the Council of said City shall employ a competent accountant or accountants to audit all books, accounts and records of said City as kept by the several officers thereof during the regular term of office of the recorder last presiding. Said accountant or accountants after having audited all said books, accounts and records shall make written report of his or their findings to the Council.

Section 2. Said accountant or accountants shall receive for services such a sum as may be agreed upon with the Council and shall be paid from the general fund in like manner as other claims against the City are paid.
