ORDINANCE NO. 470

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNERS OR PERSONS IN CONTROL OF, OR AGENTS OR PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, SUPPLIED WITH SEWER FACILITIES, TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN OR USE WATER CLOSETS OR PRIVIES THEREON WITHOUT CONNECTING THE SAME WITH LATERAL SEWERS, PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE FEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person who is the owner or in the control of, or the agent for any lot, parcel of land or premises in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall construct, maintain or use or cause to be constructed, maintained or used on said premises any water closet or privy without connecting the same with a lateral sewer of the said City by waste pipes of lawful size and quality. Provided that where there is no lateral sewer constructed adjacent to or abutting upon such premises so that such water closet or privy cannot be conveniently connected therewith then it shall be lawful to construct, maintain and use such water closet or privy without such sewer connections.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall on convection thereof before the Recorder's Court be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or be confined in the City Jail not less than two nor more than ten days, and a continuence of such violation of this ordinance for seven days after such conviction shall constitute a distinct and separate offence.

Section 3. Whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
