

ORDINANCE NO. 578

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH W.S. WEAVER FOR THE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION OF A LATERAL SEWER BEGINNING AT THE MAN HOLE IN THE OAK STREET TRUNK SEWER BETWEEN FIRST AND SECOND STREETS AND RUNNING THEREOF EASTWARD THROUGH BLOCK 16 IN HACKLEMAN'S THIRD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, WITH VITRIFIED TERRA COTTA SEWER PIPE, ACCORDING TO THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ON THE 28TH DAY OF JUNE 1916.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 43 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 28th day of June 1916, it was ordered that a lateral sewer be constructed beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street Trunk Sewer between First and Second Streets and running thence Eastward through Block 16 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon a distance of 282 feet, said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer, then on file with the Recorder of said City, and

WHEREAS it was provided ^{said} by ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany, according to said ordinance on the 9th day of August 1916, W.S. Weaver presented to the Council of said City his bid for the making of said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and by said ordinance, by which bid said W.S. Weaver proposed to furnish all materials and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement, for the sum of \$231.12, and

WHEREAS, F. B. [unclear] was the lowest bidder for said proposed work, and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor,

T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the said bid of the said W.S. Weaver for said

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improvement be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said W. S. Weaver for the making of said improvement, as aforesaid, on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of said contract, and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of September 1916; and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time.

Said contract shall further provide that the said W. S. Weaver shall promptly as due, make payment to all persons supplying to him labor or material for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work, and that the said W. S. Weaver shall not permit any lien or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the City of Albany, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of such contract on the part of said W. S. Weaver and particularly against any claim or lien for labor, work, or material on the part of any person arising out of said contract.
